Safety Alert Details:

Following a recent incident at Bucyrus Underground Mackay, stacking of Pan Sets (opposite hand (2 High) as per photo below) may result in the risk of the top pan dislodging and sliding. This can create a potential crush hazard to persons located in close proximity of the stored pans.



Bucyrus does not recommend AFC pans be stored by vertical stacking. Pan storage should be on flat level ground were ever possible, if uneven ground is the location packing should used to minimise the potential of movement

Should vertical stacking be deployed then load balance, security (rated chains or straps) and proximity of persons (barriers to general traffic) needs to be considered in order to ensure the risk of the top pan dislodging, resulting in a personnel crush injury, is controlled.
